A Letter from the Chairman



Spring is here! With Spring here and Summer around the corner, everyone is loving the weather and activities our Township has to offer including the beautiful Gilpin/Leechburg Park, our access to the Allegheny and Kiskiminetas Rivers, and our ample opportunities for ORV access. The Armstrong Trail extension through the Township is currently under construction and expected to open around July. Additionally, the converted rail-to-walking bridge in Schenley is expected to open around December. This extension will connect us to the Armstrong Trails and be a vital closure of a gap in the Erie to Pittsburgh Trail.

With good weather also comes road work. This year, the Township has faced increased cost of goods surrounding our Public Works Department leading to limited paving and sealing projects for Summer 2023. While limited by cost, the Township will still be attacking projects prioritized by resident comments and complaints. While we had hoped to attack more projects this Summer, our list had to be revamped once price estimates were obtained from PennDOT. Additionally throughout the Summer, you will see the Township mower hitting Township Right-of-Ways, and now also cutting State Right-of-Ways under contract from PennDOT.

CHAIRMAN CHARLES STULL Right-of-Ways

In April, I was happy to attend three events on behalf of our Township. On April 12, I attended the Presentation for the Governors Award for Local Government Excellence held in Harrisburg at the State Museum Auditorium. At this event, Gilpin Township and Freeport Borough were presented with an award from the Department of Community and Economic Development in the category of Intergovernmental Cooperation for the creation of Southern Armstrong Regional PD (SARPD) in October of 2022. SARPD was able to bring not only a nearly \$30k cost savings to our Township, but increase our resources for our Public Safety and maintain our 24/7 Police Coverage in the Township. Additionally, the Township received both a Senate of Pennsylvania and Pennsylvania House of Representatives Citations commemorating the award and recognizing the accomplishments of our Township.

Next, I was pleased to attend the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors 100th annual conference held in Hershey, PA April 23-26. This was my 4th conference I have attended and I learn more each year. Over the four-day conference, I attended eight classes totaling approximately ten hours. These classes included fighting blight, grant writing, battling aging infrastructure, and updates to our Second Class Township Codes. Additionally, I attended three days of General Session of the Association in which we heard from various speakers, heard and adopted the financials of the Association, and adopted Resolutions guiding the associations legislative priorities for both the Commonwealth and Federal Government. It was great to be able to bring home the knowledge and experience of this event and use it to better our Township.

Lastly, at the end of April, I was happy to attend the Gilpin Township Volunteer Fire Department annual banquet. I serve as a member of the Department and had the pleasure of presenting the Department the Township's annual donation check to thank the Department for its service and dedication to our Township.

Let's work together to show Gilpin Township's potential. Thanks for reading my first bi-annual newsletter and hopefully I will have one to follow in the Fall! Cheers to Gilpin Township!





Our Updated Zoning Ordinance has been under construction since late last year and is expected to be complete mid-tolate Summer! The process has been led by consultants from Mackin Engineering and the Zoning Steering Committe.





In April, Chairman Stull announced his appointments to the IEDAC. The purpose of the IEDAC shall be to advise the Board of Supervisors on matters dealing with the advancement and expansion of industrial and economic development within Gilpin Township. The Gilpin Township IEDAC shall aim to create a diverse business community that is prosperous and innovative while built on a stable economic foundation. The committee shall work to improve the industrial and economic environment of Gilpin Township.

Over the Summer, the Township will be completing various road projects. Of these projects, paving and sealcoating will be the largest. Bids will be opened and awarded for the projects on May 15, 2023 at 9 AM at the Township Municipal Building.





On April 29, Gilpin Twp. VFD held their annual fireman's banquet. During the event ,three members were honored for 30, 40, and 50 years of service to the Department. Additionally, the Gilpin Twp.
