Sharon Long, Secretary Treasurer, presented the minutes from the previous meeting. Kevin Miller made a motion to approve the minutes. Kris Kulick seconded. Motion carried.

Tina Thompson called into the meeting at 5:02 PM.

Sharon Long, Secretary Treasurer, presented a bills to be paid list. Kris Kulick made a motion to pay the bills. Jeremy Smail seconded. Motion carried.

Kris Kulick made a motion to table the water authority discussion. Kevin Miller seconded. Motion carried.

Kevin Miller made a motion to approve the resolution for the appointment of a CPA to audit the township books. Jeremy Smail seconded. Motion carried.

Kris Kulick made a motion to approve the tax resolution setting the milage for 2025 including a special milage for EMS. Tina Thompson seconded. Motion carried.

Charles Stull made a motion to appoint Kevin Miller as temporary chairman for the reorganization meeting. Jeremy Smail made a motion to appoint Kris Kulick as temporary chairman. Kris Kulick turned down the nomination. Tina Thompson seconded the motion for Kevin Miller. Motion carried.

Tina Thompson made a motion to set the reorganization meeting, as well as the regular meeting, on January 6, 2025, at 7 PM. Jeremy Smail seconded. Motion carried.

Kris Kulick made a motion to approve the 2025 budget. Tina Thompson seconded. Jeremy Smail stated that he didn't feel like he was heard when he brought up his issues with the donations to the Gilpin VFD, Gilpin Leechburg Park, Gilpin Leechburg Pool and the Leechburg Public Library. Motion passed 4-1.
